VOCATIONAL EDUCATION & TRAINING (VET) LEADING TO TAFE, APPRENTICESHIPS, TRAINEESHIPS & EMPLOYMENT

WHAT IS VOCATIONAL EDUCATION & TRAINING (VET)?

Vocational Education and Training pathways enable students to achieve their WACE at the completion of Year 12. All students have a greater choice of courses available as all VET students will be required to select 6 courses in Year 11 and Year 12.

Students also have the opportunity of completing and achieving one national qualification at Certificate II level (or higher) while at school in Year 11 and again in Year 12. This enables students to be more competitive for TAFE enrolments, apprenticeships, traineeships and full time employment.

WHO IS THIS TRAINING FOR?

Student who know they do not wish to attend University at the end of Year 12. This enables student to undertake a career pathway while attending school and complete the Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) at the end of Year 12.

WHY DO A VOCATIONAL EDUCATION TRAINING PROGRAM?

Advantages for students:

- Fulfil the School Curriculum & Standard Authority (SCSA) WACE requirements.
- Nationally recognised units of competence can be completed.
- Direct lead to employment.
- TAFE Entry points greatly improved if a Certificate is completed in Year 11 /12.
- Undertake Workplace Learning.

WHAT IS WORKPLACE LEARNING (WPL)?

- Work experience students have the opportunity to complete this a number of times over the year.
- SCSA endorsed course that counts towards WACE achievement.
- Student learn relevant assessable employability skills while "On the Job".
- Extra points for TAFE
- Students must select Career & Enterprise, Business Management & Enterprise or Certificate II in Skills for Work & Vocational Pathway if they wish to undertake WPL.

WACE REQUIREMENTS 2023 AND BEYOND

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

You must:

- demonstrate a minimum standard of literacy (reading and writing) and a minimum standard of numeracy,
- complete a minimum of 20 units, or equivalents,
- complete at least four Year 12 ATAR courses OR at least five Year 12 General courses and/or ATAR courses or equivalent OR a Certificate II (or higher) VET qualification in combination with ATAR, General or Foundation courses.

BREADTH AND DEPTH

You must complete a minimum of 20 units, which may include unit equivalents attained through VET and/or endorsed programs. This requirement must include at least:

- a minimum of ten Year 12 units, or the equivalent,
- four units from an English course, post-Year 10, including at least one pair of Year 12 units from an English learning area course,
- one pair of Year 12 units from each of List A (Arts/Languages/Social Sciences) and List B (Mathematics/Science/Technology) subjects.

LITERACY AND NUMERACY STANDARD

For the WACE literacy and numeracy standard you may:

- pre-qualify through achieving Band 8 or higher in the reading, writing and numeracy tests of the Year 9 National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN), or;
- demonstrate the minimum standard of literacy and numeracy by successfully completing the relevant components of the Online Literacy and Numeracy Assessment (OLNA) in Year 10, 11 or 12.

ACHIEVEMENT STANDARD

You must achieve at least 14 C grades or higher (or equivalents) in Year 11 and Year 12 units, including at least six C grades (or equivalents) in Year 12 units.

UNIT EQUIVALENTS

Unit equivalents can be obtained through VET qualifications and/or endorsed programs. The maximum number of unit equivalents available through VET and endorsed programs is four Year 11 units and four Year 12 units with a maximum of four units with endorsed programs – two in Year 11 and two in Year 12.

PRE- APPRENTICESHIP IN SCHOOL PROGRAM (PAIS)

WHAT IS PRE-APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM IN SCHOOL? (PAIS)

This program is a fast-track into an apprenticeship or further opportunities at South Regional TAFE or at the Bunbury Regional Trade Training Centre (BRTTC) sites. The PAIS program is competitive and therefore students must apply by formal written application (available from the school) and attend an interview.

To help students be competitive they must read the list of points below:

- This program is for students who already know this is the trade they wish to follow as a career path.
- It is for students that can demonstrate that they already have some understanding
 of the industry and work involved in their preferred trade.
- It is also helpful for the student to have some experience with the industry even as a home project e.g. helping building a cupboard etc.
- Students who wish to apply for this program must demonstrate a sound knowledge of year 10 Mathematics at least an "A" or "B" grade.

IMPORTANT GENERAL INFORMATION

Part of this training will be undertaken while out on work placement which will be organised by the training provider.

All courses at South Regional TAFE are free. Most courses at the BRTTC will attract fees. The school is unable to provide an accurate estimate at this time. Information will be forwarded as soon as possible.

It could be between \$1,000.00 — \$4,000.00 per program.

Some qualifications may require students to undertake additional studies outside of school terms.
